So come join us for a good time with your community, recieve some health screenings, and get some valuable information for your family.

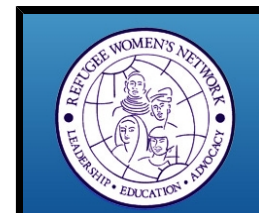
